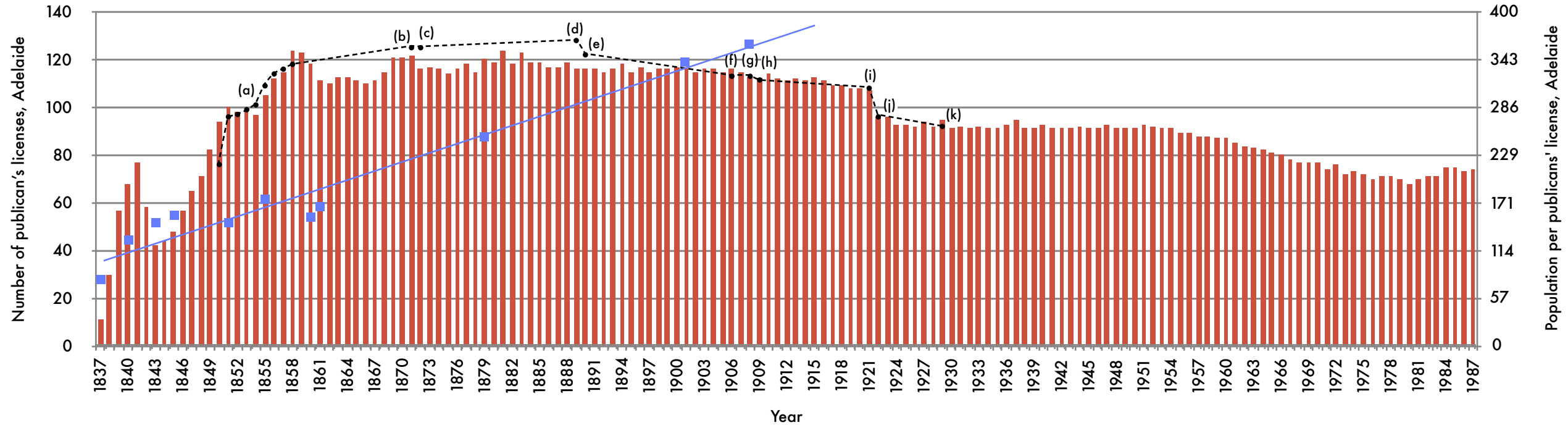


Indicative number of 'pubs' in the City of Adelaide, 1837–1987
